- Presides as master of ceremonies for visitation or graveside services
- Provides all stewards with proper equipment and guidance

Jake, Lead Habitat Steward, has been with Morgan Oaks for a year and a half.

Jake's duties include:

- Manages the habitat provided at the cemetery
- Performs all preserve upkeep and maintenance on the property, and maintains the overall appearance of the facility
- Mows Savannah grass, prunes oaks and riparian trees, manages invasives, plants trees and shrubs
- Operates various preserve equipment to carryout maintenance tasks and habitat fulfillment
- Repairs road/trail system to ensure safe passage
- Perform preventative maintenance and repairs
- Removes all debris and trash from the preserve
- Participates on teams for openings and closings of interments and inurnments. May perform disinterment.
- Determines the location and layout of individual graves complying with verification procedures
